2024 UNITED WATERVILLE FREESTYLE CUP PRESENTED BY ID ONE

Waterville Valley Resort is hosting the 2024 United Waterville Cup Presented by ID One in Moguls & Dual Moguls competitions on January 26 & 27, 2024. As the birthplace of Freestyle skiing, we are delighted and thrilled to welcome top international mogul skiers to our corner of the White Mountains. This prestigious event marks our first time hosting a FIS Freestyle World Cup event. But this isn't our first rodeo. Since Waterville Ski Resort was founded in 1966, we've hosted 11 FIS Alpine World Cup races, 4 U.S. Freestyle National Championships, 1 U.S. Alpine Championship, plus numerous freeski and snowboard U.S. Revolution Tours.



FREESTYLE LOUNGE DECK

The Freestyle Lounge, Waterville's most popular bar and après venue, has a brand-new 2,000 sq ft deck fitted with Adirondack chairs, yard games, and gas fire-pits. Over this past summer and fall, this gorgeous new deck served as an incredible addition to Waterville's s onmountain weddings. This winter, the new deck will bring a fresh twist to Freestyle Lounge après. Skiers and riders will be able to gather around a fire-pit, enjoy al fresco dining, and jam out to some live music from local musicians. The deck offers stellar views of the ski slopes. Parents will be able to lounge on Adirondack chairs while watching their kids learn on the Pasture Carpets. The Freestyle Lounge deck will be a place for skiers and riders to simply sit back, relax, and take it all in.



WHAT'S NEW, **CONTINUED**

SKI RESORT UPGRADES

Our teams built a new 2,500 sq ft room in the Base Lodge, affectionately named "The Hideaway". This room will serve as a dining and gathering space for Junior Seasonal Programs and Silver Streaks, further expanding our usable space in the base lodge. During wedding season, the Hideaway operates as a Bridal Suite for our on-mountain weddings. Out on the slopes, our teams have been working across the entire mountain. We plan on making more snow this year - we installed additional snow fan guns on Valley Run and Lower Bobby's Run! Down at the Pasture Carpets, we've installed a new carpet belt. This new carpet belt is lighter and stronger than its predecessor. Plus, it's been fusion-spliced, mitigating stoppages throughout the winter. Up at the summit area, we are building a brand-new, 2-story Ski Patrol and sled garage, located adjacent to the top of the Northside chairlift.

EMPLOYEE HOUSING

We've made major upgrades to our employee housing. The Snowstar, Waterville's 62person employee housing building, received a new roof, new windows, and new siding. We're now in the process of renovating every single room. These enhancements will benefit the lives of a large portion of our year-round and seasonal team, including younger employees, international employees, and employees relocating from out of state.

Waterville Valley Resort is hosting the 2024 FIS World Cup Moguls and Dual Moguls competitions. This world-class event is planned to take place on Lower Bobby's Run, a beloved double-black diamond run named after the late Robert F. Kennedy, who was a frequent visitor of Waterville Valley. At 246 meters long with a pitch of 28 degrees, the eastern-facing course is perfect for mogul-style events, especially considering the expansive viewing area towards the bottom of the run. Fans, spectators, and budding athletes will be able to cheer on these incredible professional freestyle skiers while taking in spectacular views of the course.



The Nordic Center manages and maintains Waterville Valley's expansive cross-country trail system – grooming over 70+ km of trails for both skate and classic skiing. Snowshoeing is welcome on any trail and fat biking is welcome on select trails with the purchase of a trail pass. Dogs are also welcome on select trails.


FREESTYLE LOUNGE
